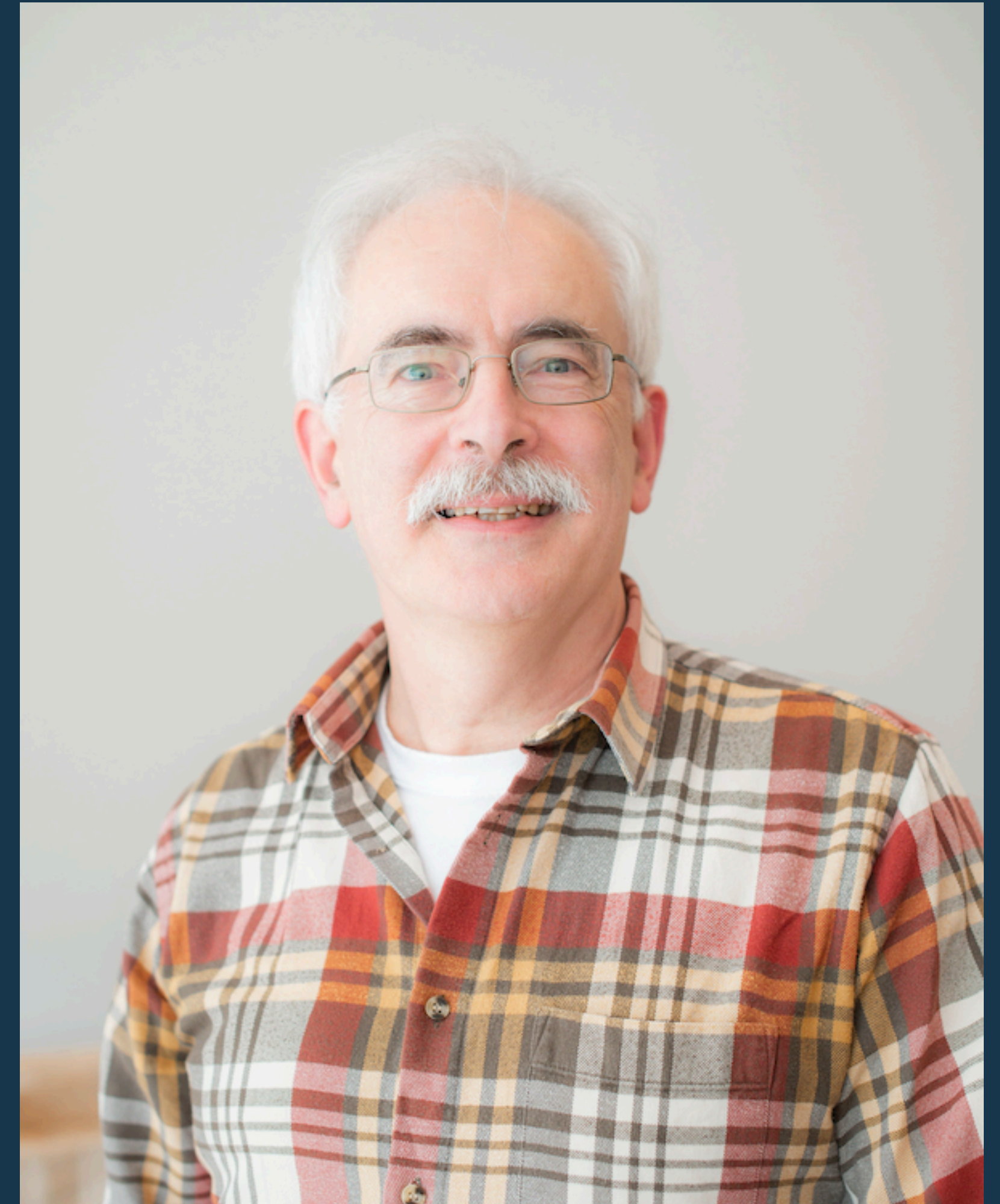

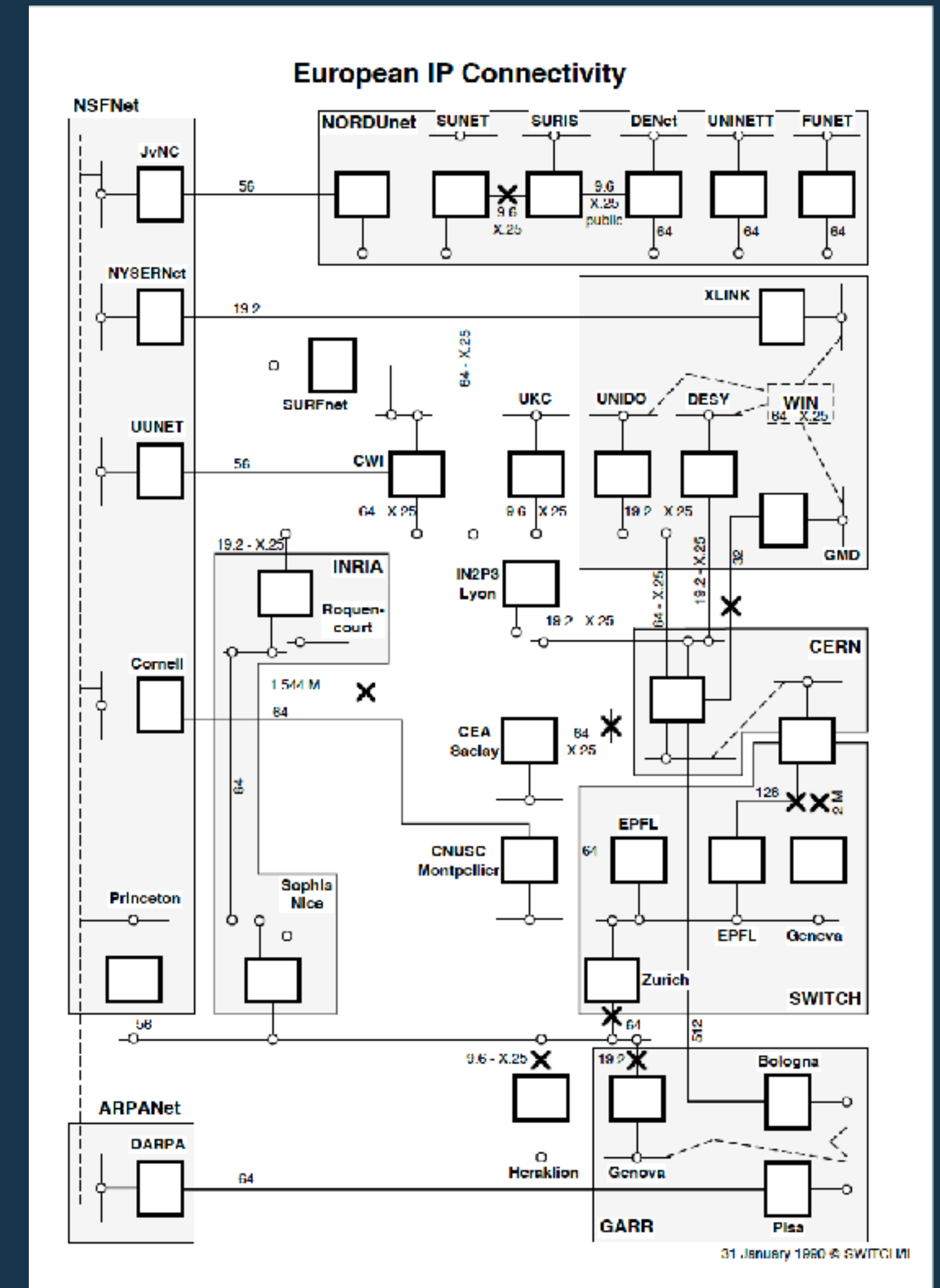

RIPE Programme Committee (PC)

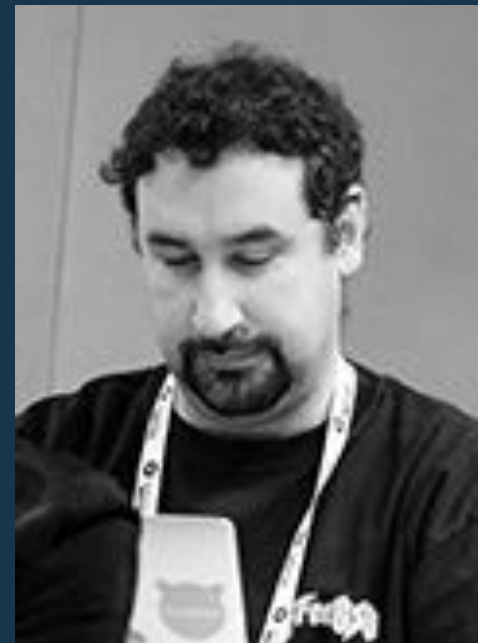
/responsibilities

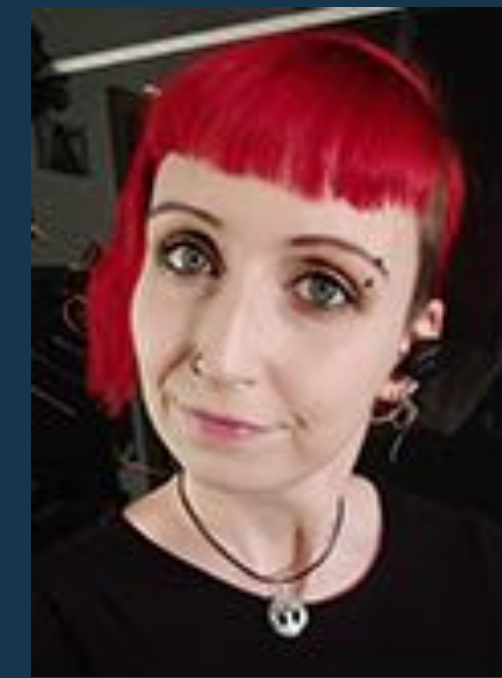

- Maintains the RIPE Database
- Allocates and manages Internet number resources via the LIR Portal
- Investigates hijacks and policy violations
- Supports and facilitates the Policy Development Process with the community
- Ensures secure routing with RPKI

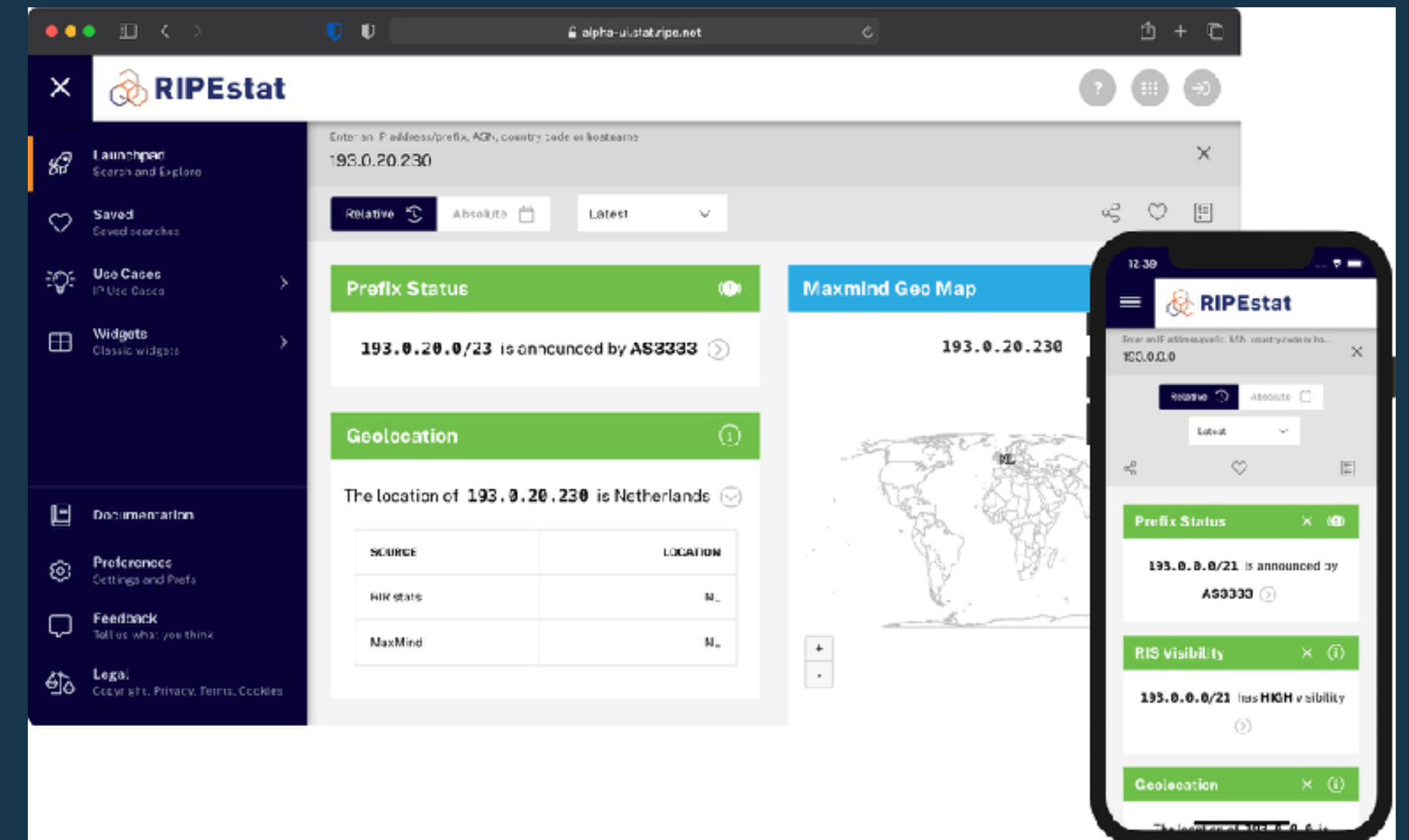


Information Services

/RIPE-NCC



- Develops and maintains Internet measurement services (RIPEstat, RIPE Atlas, RIS, RIPE IPmap)
- Operates K-root, one of the 13 root-name servers
- Delegates reverse DNS zones for the address ranges we manage and provides reliable, authoritative name servers



Community and Engagement

- Offers training courses, e-learning and professional certifications
- Contributes to public policy and Internet Governance discussions

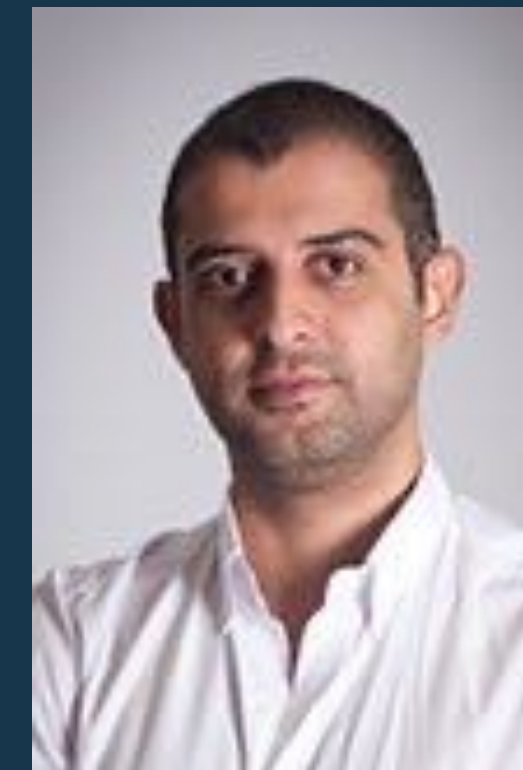

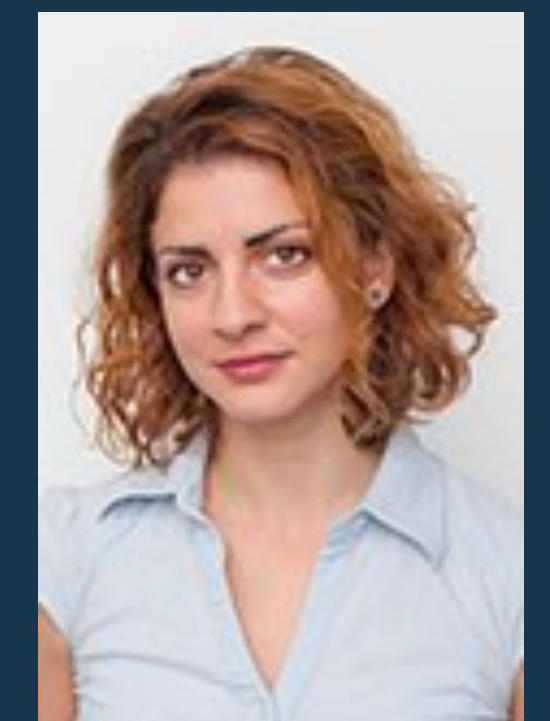

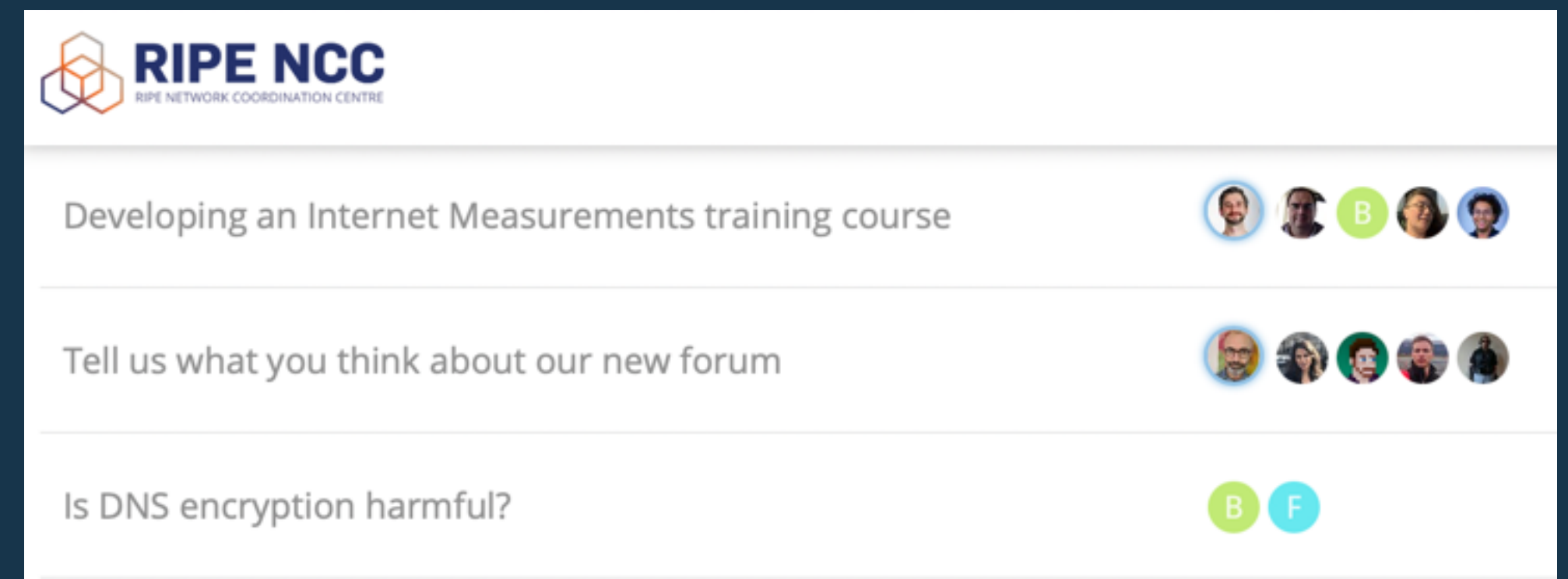
